

Your Financial Revolution: Understanding How The Kingdom Operates, 2.26.17

Introduction:

1. Review of previous two messages. Living in rest rather than worry. Knowing that all our needs are met and we have more than enough
2. **"Matt.5.3"** – God gives the Kingdom to His followers. He has given us authority on earth to bring His dominion to the earth realm. It is the opposite of the Earth Cursed System.
3. God wants you to live your purpose rather than just paying off things. You have to get the money thing right or you will never live out your purpose. Otherwise, it becomes all about retirement when you can finally do what you want.
4. Matt.6.24 – You are going to serve the one who meets your needs – God or ECS. In the ECS, you will either never have enough, or you will hoard it. Either way, you are living in fear. Working, working, working, etc.

Identify what you have need of and sow it into the Kingdom – Mark 6.35-38.

1. They needed food so they brought food to Jesus.
2. Money has no designation; it is a blank seed, so when you give you designate what you need – need a job, bills paid, debt, taxes.
3. When Stephanie & I give an offering we tell the Lord what we exactly need.
4. Luke 6.38 – whatever you need sow it into the KOG

Bring it under the dominion of the Kingdom – 6.37-41.

1. They had the EC mindset – pain, toil and sweat. It's the way most think about financial need.
2. Jesus blessed it, set it apart. It left the ECS and moved into the KOG. Now, God can do something amazing with it.
3. This is when I release my faith. I set that thing aside to God and I begin thanking Him for the provision and abundance that He will bring. I think this is where a lot of us fall short. We don't anticipate any change. The offering is an obligation or act of obedience but there is not much faith behind it. Remember this is a law in the KOG, just like the law of gravity.
4. Important Faith Principles:
 - a. Have it grounded in Scripture.
 - b. Be specific and speak over it.
 - c. Stay within your developed faith.
 - d. Be in agreement with a person of faith. Amanda Mize and Edward Jones adviser. You need someone who has faith. Preferably, your spouse needs to stand with you on this.

Be sensitive to the plan of the Holy Spirit – 6.39-40, 41.

1. They had to follow the plan or it could have been chaotic and people would not have been fed. It would have been like some third world natural disaster relief effort.
2. There is a way that God wants you to capture wealth with an idea, plan, direction, a contact, an insight, a resource, opportunity, a certification or degree, etc. God may lay your need upon someone's heart, but normally it's through a means that God gives you the plan.
3. Ill – Spirit prompting me to check my escrow account.
4. We can't have a "mailbox mentality."

Act on it

1. The disciples got right after the distribution. These people were hungry and action was needed.
2. Don't just think about it, but rather get up and do it. Quit procrastinating and asking others for their opinions.
 - a. Getting my PME behind me and now they've changed the whole program.
3. One of the greatest life principles is "Figure it out as you're going along." Some want everything lined out step by step, but when the HS is moving you don't ask about the long term plan.
 - a. You will feel unsure, uneasy and even fearful, b/c it's not the way you've always done it. It is different and it's growing your faith.
 - b. If you want to get to the next place you have to walk through the open door and not worry about having all the answers.
4. What door has he opened?
5. 1 Cor.2.7-8: God's wisdom was hidden from the devil. If he had known it, he would not have crucified Jesus.
 - a. David & Goliath. David rushed to meet Goliath. He didn't give the enemy time to prepare. If he had been dancing around for 15 minutes, then Goliath would have had his shield up
 - b. We act b/c the enemy is trying to supplant the work of God. When the HS leads you don't hesitate.

Gather up what is left over – 6.42-43.

1. God doesn't just want us to have our needs met in that moment, but He wants us to live in overflow.
2. What did you learn...what worked...who did you meet...are there fragments out there that I can work with?
3. God is going to point out little things that are typically overlooked that will not only be a source of blessing for us, but for others too.
4. Mark 8 – They didn't take any fragments with them and they ran out of food.
